



# Lee's Summit Soccer Association

## Frequently ask Questions:

**Q: Why are the player registration fees going up again in 2012?**

A: In 2010 the Lee's Summit Soccer Association (LSSA) paid an average annual fee of \$1.00 per player for the use of school district practice fields. In 2012 the new practice field rental expense has increased to an annual cost of \$20.00 per player for those same fields.

**Q: Are the LSSA board members compensated for their time?**

A: No, the Lee's Summit Soccer Association (LSSA) Executive Board or Officers are elected for two year terms and the general board members such as Division Representatives or Assistant Commissioners are each appointed by the Executive Board. Neither levels are compensated.

**Q: How can I get more involved in LSSA?**

A: It's quite simple, go to the web site, [www.lssa.org](http://www.lssa.org) and click on the link at the bottom of the web site titled "Volunteer Opportunities" on the next screen select the category that best fits you.

**Q: Do you anticipate league fees to continue to grow in 2013?**

A: No, based on conversations amongst the Executive Board, Lee's Summit Parks and Recreation and the Lee's Summit School District the board does not anticipate another fee increase in the foreseeable future.

**Q: Over the past five years has LSSA added any new programs to the league?**

A: Yes, as the Lee's Summit Soccer Association (LSSA) continues to grow so do the number of great programs the league offers. For example: 1) the adult soccer division continues to grow participation with each season; 2) the new LS Juniors program, designed for first time players (3 years of age) continues to see larger enrollment numbers; 3) nearly 100% of our teams are now training up to two nights a week all season long as well as playing a minimum of one game per weekend; 4) the post season tournament bracket has changed to a "round robin" format where teams are now guaranteed more games; 5) ALL players are eligible to participate in FREE summer camps with collegiate coaches and players from around the metropolitan area (this three day camp alone is worth over \$100.00 per player); 6) LSSA now offers five free winter indoor training sessions for speed & agility, two FREE striker camps and a FREE keeper camp open to all LSSA players; 7) Indoor 3v3 youth recreational soccer league; 8) Adult indoor winter leagues; 9) Additional FREE coaches training and certification clinic; 10) Access to Director of Coaching sessions for both coaches and players which are also FREE.

These are only ten of the many positive changes you will experience as a member of LSSA. These ten items don't include facility improvements and site amenities such as new pedestrian trails, new member restroom facilities, additional passenger carts and more.
