By participating in LSSA, the player and parent/guardian agree to abide by the rules and regulations established by the Lee's Summit Soccer Association. The player and parent/guardian agree that they will conduct themselves in a manner that creates and maintains a safe, friendly and learning environment for all participants. The player and parent/guardian also agree to treat all players, coaches, referees and LSSA volunteers with respect. The player and parent/guardian understand that unsportsmanlike conduct is prohibited and players, parents and/or spectators may be requested to leave the premise if they don't comply with the rules and regulations established. Repeat offenders may also be placed on probation or expelled from the league. If a player or coach is expelled from the league a refund will not be issued. Coaches who receive a Red Card will result in ejection from that game and shall prohibit the coach from coaching the next regularly scheduled league game. The player and parent/guardian further agree to park only in designated parking stalls at Legacy Park. LSSA no longer permits pets at the soccer venue.

KIDS LOVE LSSA SOCCER

Soccer is a great way to introduce children to sports through team play. LSSA emphasizes teaching the fundamentals of soccer and **REQUIRES** that each child plays at least one half of each game. LSSA's recreational outdoor program is designed to develop and challenge players, but most of all, allow them to have fun. LSSA is a not-for-profit, volunteer-run organization committed to providing our community with a value priced, high quality soccer program. Over 3000 kids from Lee's Summit participate each season at the Legacy Park Soccer Venue.

GAME LOCATION: Games are played at the Legacy Park Soccer Venue located at 1501 & 1601 NE Blackwell Road. Bring your own chair and please leave your pets at home. Due to previous incidents, LSSA no longer allows **pets** at the soccer venue.

UNIFORMS/GEAR: LSSA provides black socks in the fall seasons and a team shirt that must always be the outermost clothing article worn while in the game. Black shorts are the player's choice, but not required. Shin guards are **REQUIRED** to participate in LSSA games and practices. Soccer cleats are optional, but we **DON'T** allow baseball cleats (a baseball cleat has a cleat on the front of the sole) or football (rectangular cleats on the outmost part of the sole). The league does not provide soccer balls for players during practice, only game day game balls.

Size 3 for U5 (Under 5 years old), U6, U7 and U8

Size 4 for U9, U10 and U12

Size 5 for U15 and HS

AGES: LSSA starts at age 4 and continues up high school (as of July 31, 2010). LSSA has separate divisions for girls and boys and divides the divisions by age. A photocopy of the player's birth certificate is required to be on file at LSSA. Similar to beginning school, the age requirement is only evaluated once a year. Therefore, your child must be 4 years old by **July 31, 2010**, to participate in the Fall 2010 soccer season.

FEES: On time, on-line registrations are \$55. Late registrations (are only accepted on-line and require an additional \$15 late fee per player). Families with three or more registered players in a single season will receive a \$10 discount on each child's fee (\$55 per player on time or \$70 for a late registration). At least three children in a family must be playing in the recreational division during the current season to qualify for the discount, competitive player discounts do not apply.

TEAM ORGANIZATION: LSSA allows teams to remain together from one season to the next, however, not all players register from season to season. New players are welcomed and will be placed on teams through the player draft. LSSA strives to balance teams when adding players into the division, and therefore, requests to play for a specific coach or with a specific player will only be honored at the discretion of the LSSA board. Additionally, if desired, parents may request their child be drafted onto a different team at the conclusion of any season.

SCHEDULE: Regular scheduled games are primarily played on Saturdays between 8am-7pm and occasional make up games will be played on Sundays generally between 11am-7pm. Opening weekend will be the August 21, 2010. We make every effort to play seven regular season games exclusive of a post season tournament scheduled for the last weekend of the regular season (no tournament for U5 & U6 Divisions – one game on Saturday or Sunday instead). Mother Nature does not always cooperate with our schedule and make up games are held on Sundays.

PRACTICES: Coaches schedule practices at various schools, parks, churches and occasionally on private property with the consent of the league. Generally, practices will be scheduled twice a week up until the first game and either once or twice a week once games begin. Practices may start anytime after August 1, 2010.

REGISTRATION: On-line registrations are our preferred method of registering because it minimizes the chance of forms getting lost and increases the timing of our process. However, we still accept hard copies, simply complete the form on the front and return to the address provided. The registration fees includes a team shirt, black socks (fall only), individual picture, team picture, and an individual participation trophy. Players are **not asked** to sell candy/promotional goods.

DEADLINE: LSSA guarantees placement of all players with registrations received by July 2, 2010. We cannot guarantee placement on a team for registrations after this date, however registration fees will be refunded if a player cannot be placed on a team. Late registrations require an additional \$15 per player.

REFUNDS: Full refunds will be given if requested by August 1, 2010. Refunds must be requested on-line at www.lssa.org/pages/refund or in writing delivered to The UPS Store, 705B SE Melody Lane, PMB 303, Lee's Summit, MO 64063
